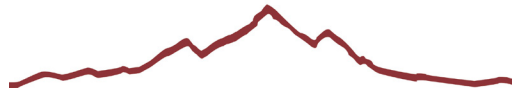


MAIN DIVIDE

SELECT SOUTHERN WINE



Sauvignon Blanc 2019

Grapes:	100% Sauvignon Blanc
Region:	Waipara Valley / North Canterbury
Vineyards:	From several North Canterbury vineyards
Exposure:	North
Altitude:	60 meters above sea level
Soil:	Wind blown loess over free draining soil
Vine Training:	Vertical shoot position and Scott Henry
Vine Age:	8 years old
Time of Harvest:	Early April
Yields (vine or acre):	4 tons per acre
Total Production:	27,438 bottles
Vinification Process:	The grapes were picked in separate batches during April. After gentle pressing of the berries, the juice ferments in stainless steel tanks at cool temperatures.
Aging Process:	The wine undergoes no oak aging
Alcohol Content:	12.50%
Dry Extract:	25.5 g/l
Total Acid:	7.5 g/l
Tasting Notes:	The wine is pale lemon in color, with vibrant tropical fruit aromas of passionfruit and lychees. Layered beneath that there are hints of gooseberry, citrus, and dried herbs. The palate is generous, yet remains fresh and lively, with a satisfyingly crisp finish.
Winemaker:	Matt Donaldson
Winery Philosophy:	Main Divide wines are made by the Donaldson family at Pegasus Bay. Fruit for Main Divide comes from selected North Canterbury growers chosen for the ability to express unique regional and varietal characters.
Cellaring:	3-5 years
Bottled:	July 2018
Closure:	Screwcap
Food/Menu Pairing:	Makes a great aperitif, perfect with light fresh seafood dishes such as sushi, scallops, oysters, white fleshed fish.
