Grapes:	Made with Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Merlot marcs from Terrabianca's wines
Region:	Tuscany
Vineyard Locations:	From two vineyards located in the 1) Chianti Classico and 2) Maremma regions
Exposure:	Southwest
Altitude:	1)1,150-1,310 feet above sea level 2)650-820 feet above sea level
Soil:	1)Calcareous-cretaceous substrata of sand and clay 2) Terrains with loamy texture evolving towards clay loam/clay ("red soil")
Vine Training:	Spur-pruned cordon
Vine Age:	15 to 20 years old, with some around 8 years old
Time of Harvest:	September to October
Vines Density:	2,430 vines per acre
Aging Process:	The grappa is aged three months in Cherrywood
Alcohol Content:	45.00%
Tasting Notes:	The grappa is transparent with a faint straw yellow hue, wonderful floral notes and hints of ripe fruit.
