Grapes:	100% Nebbiolo
Region:	Piedmont
Vineyard Location:	From the Mosconi cru of Monforte d'Alba
Vineyard Size:	1 hectare (2.47 acres)
Exposure:	South
Altitude:	400 meters (1,312 feet) above sea level
Soil:	Calcareous marl, with a high percentage of silt and sand
Vine Training:	Guyot
Vine Age:	20-60 years old
Year Planted:	1960, 1999
Time of Harvest:	Mid-October
Vine Density:	4,500-5,000 vines per hectare
Vine Yield:	5.5- 6 tons per hectare
Total Production:	6,000 bottles approx
Vinification Process:	The grapes undergo maceration on skins in rotating paddle fermenters for approximately 12 to 15 days.
Aging Process:	The wine ages 24 months in French barrique, followed by about 12 months in the bottle.
Alcohol Content:	13.5%
Tasting Notes:	Deep garnet in color, fruity bouquet recalling brushwood, berry fruit and briar rose; gorgeous structure, ripe, rich tannins; complex and austere.
Winemaker:	Guido and Fabio Fantino
Cellaring:	10-20 years
Closure:	Natural Cork
Food/Menu Pairing:	A wonderful accompaniment to meat, pasta and aged cheese.
