Grapes:	A field blend of Cannonau, Caricaggiola, Pascale di Cagliari, Dolcetto, Barbera, and Cabernet Franc
Region:	Sardinia
Vineyards:	From a single vineyard at Alta Gallura, Sardinia Sant'Antonio di Gallura
Vineyard Size:	> 1 hectar
Exposure:	Southeast
Altitude:	1,312 feet above sea level (400 meters)
Soil:	Granite
Vine Training:	Pruned-spur cordon-trained
Vine Age:	85 years
Time of Harvest:	Early October
Vine Density:	4,500 vines per hectar
Vine Yield:	3 tons per hectar
Total Production:	2,000 bottles
Vinification Process:	The grapes ferment in thermo-controlled, stainless steel vats.
Aging Process:	The wine ages 12 months in new French barriques and several months in the bottle.
Alcohol Content:	14.00%
Tasting Notes:	The color is deep and impenetrable, with hints of Vanilla and red berries on the nose, and a slight spicy note. On the palate it is soft and accompanied by an elegant finish.

Cellaring:	15 years

Closure:	Natural Cork
Food/Menu Pairing:	Pairs well with red meats as well as rich fish such as Tuna, Swordfish and Salmon.
