Region:	Piedmont
Vineyards:	From vineyards located in the Comune Montaldo Roero
Vineyard Size:	2 hectares
Exposure:	South
Altitude:	300 meters (984 feet) above sea level
Soil:	Calcareous sand
Vine Training:	Guyot
Vine Age:	9-17 years old
Year Planted:	From 2004-2012
Time of Harvest:	Early September
Vine Density:	5,000 vines per hectare
Vinification Process:	The hand-picked grapes are selected in the vineyard. Vinification takes place in stainless steel under a controlled temperature.
Aging Process:	The wine ages on the fine lees for three months.
Alcohol Content:	13.00%
Tasting Notes:	Straw-colored with an extensive, fragrant bouquet, with hints of fresh fruit, acacia flowers and honey.
Winemaker:	Marcarini family and Valter Bonetti
Cellaring:	Do not cellar, drink young
Closure:	DIAM
Food/Menu Pairing:	A superb accompaniment with hors d'oeuvres, risottos, gnocchi alla bava, or fish without sauce
