Grapes:	100% Nerello Mascalese
Region:	Sicily
Vineyards:	From a single vineyard near the town of Castiglione di Sicilia
Exposure:	Castiglione di Sicilia
Altitude:	Northern slopes
Soil:	1,968 feet above sea level
Vine Training:	Stony, light sandy loam
Vine Age:	Espalier Trained
Time of Harvest:	40-50 years old
Vine Density:	Mid October
Vine Yield:	2,024 vines per acre
Total Production:	12,000 bottles
Vinification Process:	The grapes are harvested by hand and soft pressed
Aging Process:	The wine ages in stainless steel and rests in the bottle before release
Alcohol Content:	13.00%
Tasting Notes:	Soft pink in color. The wine shows lovely flowers and herbs, distinctive acidity and the typical minerality of Etna wines.
Winemaker:	Carlo Ferrini
Winemaker's Comments:	Pietradolce Etna Rosato shows distinctive minerality and complexity combined with an intense, ample bouquet of rich aromas. These characteristics make this a very supple and versatile wine.
Cellaring:	Up to 3 years

Food/Menu Pairing:	Pairs well with grilled vegetables and pizza. Very flexible wine.
