Founded in 1962, Viña Sol's timeless appeal, approachable palate, and ability to pair well with a variety of dishes has led to its popularity with thousands of consumers. Today, it is Torres' largest brand.

### The History

Viña Sol was founded in 1962, a fascinating year, and like many of the icons of the Sixties it has become a timeless and popular icon throughout the world.

The name and the label symbolize the winery's beginnings. The Mediterranean sun used to be stamped on the barrels that were sent from Spain to Cuba and Puerto Rico.

Viña Sol has evolved alongside the tastes of thousands of consumers in over 40 countries. It started out as a symbol of modernism and sixty years later, it can be considered a timeless classic.

### The Terroir

Catalunya is situated at the very northeast of Spain, right at the border of southern France. The climate is Mediterranean and continental. The soils are calcareous sedimentary deposits that are poor in organic matter, with silt and clay while the begin at sea level and go all the way up to 800 meters (over 2,600 feet). Some of the regions where grapes are harvested include Penedès, Terra Alta, Priorat, and Costers del Segre.



**MEDITERRANEAN WHITE BLEND:** A blend of mainly Parellada and White Garnacha from vineyards throughout Catalunya. The Parellada are harvested in late September and the White Garnacha grapes are harvested in late August. The grapes go through controlled-temperature fermentation in stainless steel tanks for 14 days. Clear, clean, bright gold in color. Fresh, full of fruit, with fine citrus aromas. Silky, with subtle acidity and a delicate midpalate. Excellent as an aperitif or paired with rice dishes, shellfish and other fish. Serve at 10°C.
