



## Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

<b>Grapes:</b>	84% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Malbec, 5% Merlot, and 5% Petite Sirah
<b>Region:</b>	Paso Robles
<b>Vineyard Location:</b>	Adelaida, Willow Creek, Templeton Gap, Creston, El Pomar, and Estrella Districts of the Paso Robles AVA
<b>Vineyard Size:</b>	Smallest 3 acres, largest 200 acres
<b>Exposure:</b>	Mostly west and south facing
<b>Altitude:</b>	900-1700 feet above sea level
<b>Soil:</b>	Alluvial, calcareous, and clay loam
<b>Vine Training:</b>	VSP
<b>Vine Age:</b>	6-20 years old
<b>Time of Harvest:</b>	Sep/Oct 2021
<b>Vinification Process:</b>	Fruit is destemmed and cold-soaked for 3-5 days. This is followed by fermentation with pump-overs and punchdowns three times a day.
<b>Aging Process:</b>	Ages 10 months in stainless steel tanks and French barrique, 20% new.
<b>Alcohol Content:</b>	14.5%
<b>Acid (total):</b>	6.16 g/L
<b>Acid (volatile):</b>	0.54 g/L
<b>Residual Sugar:</b>	0.4 g/L
<b>PH:</b>	3.97
<b>Tasting Notes:</b>	Chocolate-blackberry ganache, cranberry preserves, sweet mint, black licorice, dark olive, new leather, and mahogany. The palate is sleek and supple, with fine-grained, polished tannins, and a complex and classy finish.
